Page 1, Section 1:

Current:

No lot or part thereof in the Riverside Cemetery shall hereafter be sold, leased or any rights granted therein until the purchaser thereof shall pay to the Clerk of the Board of Cemetery Trustees, a sum of money, the interest or income from which sum, the Board of Cemetery Trustees shall determine as reasonable necessary for the perpetual care of such lot or portion thereof.

Proposed:

A resident means an individual domiciled in the City of Menominee. Domicile means a place where a person has his or her true, fixed, and permanent residence to which, whenever absent, he or she intends to return, and which continues until a different permanent residence is established. An individual can have only one (1) domicile.

For the purpose of applying cemetery rates, in addition to city residents as defined above, residency status shall apply to a person who already has a spouse buried in the cemetery; or has resided within the city for no less than one year immediately preceding the person's death or purchase of burial rights (lot); or is a lifetime resident who has moved to an assisted living facility.

Proof of residency is required. Documentation required may include current:

- Voter registration card
- Homesteaded tax bill
- State issued identification or driver's license
- Payroll stub
- Utility bill(s): water, WPS, cable, telephone

Page 2, Section 5:

Current:

Purchasers of lots acquire simply the right and privilege of burial of the dead.

Proposed:

Residents may purchase gravesites for themselves, a spouse or significant other, and dependents at the residency rate established by the Cemetery Board of Trustees.

Residents may purchase additional gravesites for family member(s) at a rate determined by the family member(s)'s residency status at the time of purchase. Proof of their residency is required. All gravesites must be designated by purchaser prior to the issuance of a deed for burial rights.

Purchasers of lots acquire simply the right and privilege of burial of the dead.
